

Learning in class



Early Years

In Early Years we have been reading the book We're Going on a Bear Hunt. The children listened to the story and acted it out in different ways, using different props, both inside and outside. We had a special 'Teddy Bear Day' where the children could all bring in their favourite teddy bear and we completed lots of different bear themed activities, including having a Teddy Bears Picnic for Lunch.










Year 3

Year 3 have been busy learning about the Romans this term and are very excited to be making their own 'modern day Roman shields' in art. They have been busy creating their designs which are inspired by the Romans but show what their personalities are like. They cannot wait to make their shields next week using paper mâché to join their forms to the shield so they are 3D. They will then paint them with bright colours. I can't wait to see them finished!









Year 6

This term, the children in Year 6 are learning about Micro:bits which are tiny computers that can be programmed with a code or algorithm. The children have made name badges and beating heart animations so far and are already experimenting, debugging and using their creativity with coding.

World Religion Day

This week in our assembly and to continue promoting our value of Respect, we looked at World Religion Day which was celebrated on Sunday 19th January. It's a day when we aim to promote understanding and peace between religions as well as mutual respect and tolerance of people from different backgrounds. We watched a video of some different religious festivals which all looked very joyous! There are some lovely videos which can be watched here to introduce children to different religions as well.



Ogden Trust Science Olympics

We took 10 Year 6 children to represent St John's in the Science Olympics at Ling Moor Primary Academy with other schools from the Priory trust. The children had to take part in 5 different scientific challenges including designing a parachute for an egg, a bridge to hold the most weight, a boat which would take the most weight on water and the strongest tower made from spaghetti and marshmallows. The children worked so well together, showing great communication, teamwork and problem solving. St John's won 3 out of the 5 different challenges which is a terrific achievement! Well done to all who participated.









Phonics Sessions

Families of children in Early Years and Key Stage One will be receiving a letter inviting you to come in and see phonics in action in our school. We absolutely love our new phonics



programme and Little Wandle and the children are making excellent progress with it. You'd be very welcome to come and see a session so you can see how new sounds and decoding skills are taught and how we segment words to spell. We look forward to welcoming you into classes where I know the children will be very keen to show off their expert knowledge!

Maths Hub

We have also been making some changes to our Maths curriculum and have been working alongside the Maths Hub to make sure we are delivering a curriculum based on the latest research around effective Maths teaching. Our children in Early Years and Key Stage One are re-



ally enjoying their Mastering Number sessions where they are becoming quite the experts at using Rekenreks. The teachers benefitted from some training from Liam Bielby, one of the specialists working with the Maths hub and we're excited to watch our Maths curriculum go from strength to strength.
